

Q. How to reboot Vigor router by schedule?

VigorPro5510, VigorPro5300 and Vigor2820 support Auto Reboot by time schedule.

Please refer to the steps below for configurations:

1. Make sure Vigor router has the correct time via **System Maintenance>> Time and Date** page.
